Report Cards

Report cards are available after the end of each quarter for a limited time. These can be accessed through your ParentVUE portal. At the middle school level, report card reminders are sent electronically to parents. Your student's report card will be in your ParentVUE account under the Report Card section on the left hand side of your screen. In order to receive a report card for your child, you will need to have an activated ParentVUE account for your child.



Register to Receive a Report Card:


Login to your ParentVUE account.

Find the recycling icon and check the statement, "I only want to receive my child's report card on-line, do not send me a printed report card."




To View Your Child's Report Card in the Report Card Tab:

Click back on the **Home** Tab in the upper left corner and then locate the **Report Card** Tab.

This is where you **will** see an overview of your child's report card. For a more detailed version, click on the statement "Click here to view report card for Quarter 1".



Under the the report card you will notice a **Grade Legend**. Please know that this shows grade scales for all of our schools and Orange Grove uses a rubric grading system. 

| 3.0 | Proficient: Student produces work that meets expectations; frequently produces work of high quality, successfully demonstrating mastery of the content (skills/concepts) in the district curriculum standards.
