


Report Cards

Report cards are available after the end of each quarter. These can be accessed through your ParentVUE portal. At the middle school level, report card reminders are sent electronically to parents. Your student's report card will be in your ParentVUE account under the Report Card section on the left hand side of your screen. In order to receive a report card for your child, you will need to have an activated ParentVUE account for your child.



Register to Receive a Report Card:


Login to your **ParentVUE** account.


